American Airlines is one of the core businesses of AMR Corporation. In 1982, stockholders voted to approve a plan of reorganization under which a new holding company, AMR Corp., was formed and became the parent company to American Airlines.

American Airlines includes American's Passenger and Cargo divisions as well as operation of American Eagle, American Airlines' regional airline affiliate. American's Passenger division is one of the largest scheduled passenger airlines in the world.

American provides scheduled jet service to destinations throughout North America, the Caribbean, Latin America, Europe and the Pacific, serving 250 cities in over 40 countries with more than 3,400 daily flights.

American Airlines and Asia Pacific

American Airlines now operates daily roundtrip flights from Japan to the following major cities in the United States: Chicago (ORD), Los Angeles (LAX), New York (JFK) and Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW). Notably, American is the only U.S. carrier with nonstop service from Tokyo to New York (JFK). American also provides daily nonstop service from Chicago (ORD) to Pudong International Airport (PVG) in Shanghai.

May 1987	Narita - Dallas-Fort Worth service begins, marking American's first Asia Pacific route
May 1998	Narita - Chicago service begins; MD11 fleet provides service for the route
September 2000	Boeing 777 fleet begins service to Japan
April 2002	Narita - New York JFK service begins
June 2002	Narita - Dallas-Fort Worth service increases to 11 flights a week
June 2003	Narita - Dallas-Fort Worth service increases to 12 flights a week
April 2004	Narita - Los Angeles service begins
December 2004	Narita - Dallas-Fort Worth service increases to 13 flights a week
December 2005	Narita - Dallas-Fort Worth service increases to 14 flights a week
April 2006	Shanghai - Chicago service begins
January 2007	American Airlines operations relocate to new Terminal 2 at Narita International Airport, including co-location with four oneworld Alliance airlines; a new state-of-the-art Admirals Club opens
