oneworld™ Web Page Has A New Look & New Features



The website for oneworld Alliance, www.oneworld.com has a fresh new look and some fantastic new features.

The new site includes an interactive map displaying the routes of all eight oneworld airlines and oneworld affiliates, an airport lounge directory with information about nearly 400

lounges worldwide, and for the first time, a search function. The oneworld group includes 8 airline partners (American Airlines, British Airways, Cathay Pacific, Qantas, Iberia, LAN, Finnair, AerLingus) and 12 other airlines. This consortium covers 8,150 flights to 135 countries and 600 cities everyday.

Starting in 2007, Japan Airlines, Marebu Hungary, and Royal Jordanian will join the alliance network expanding it by 6 countries and 100 cities, bringing the oneworld alliance to offer over 9,000 flights per day.
